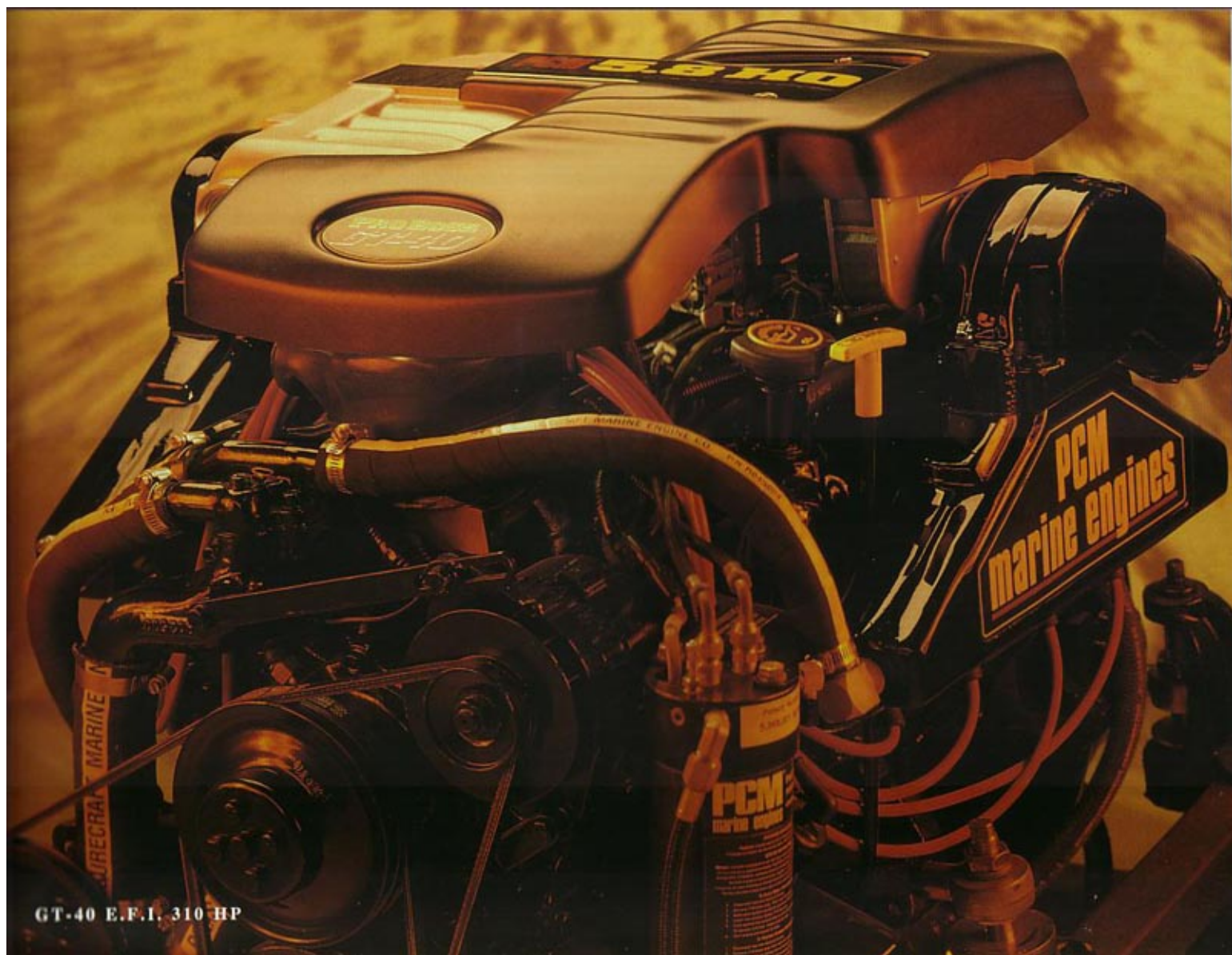
Correct Craft and PCM® were the first to develop a reduction gear designed specifically for tournament water skiing applications. The first to significantly reduce engine noise

with the Vernay muffler system. The first to develop a totally electronic management system to control all the critical functions of the inboard power plant.

With the support of Ford Motor Company in cooperation with PCM®, Correct Craft introduced the first Pro Boss® GT-40 multi-port electronic fuel-injected engine. The result? A pulse-defying 310 horsepower rocketship, with 385 foot-pounds of tantalizing torque. Today, there's even more horses under the hood, 430 to be exact, as Correct Craft and PCM® debuted the sizzling Python™ engine at the prestigious Masters Waterski Tournament.

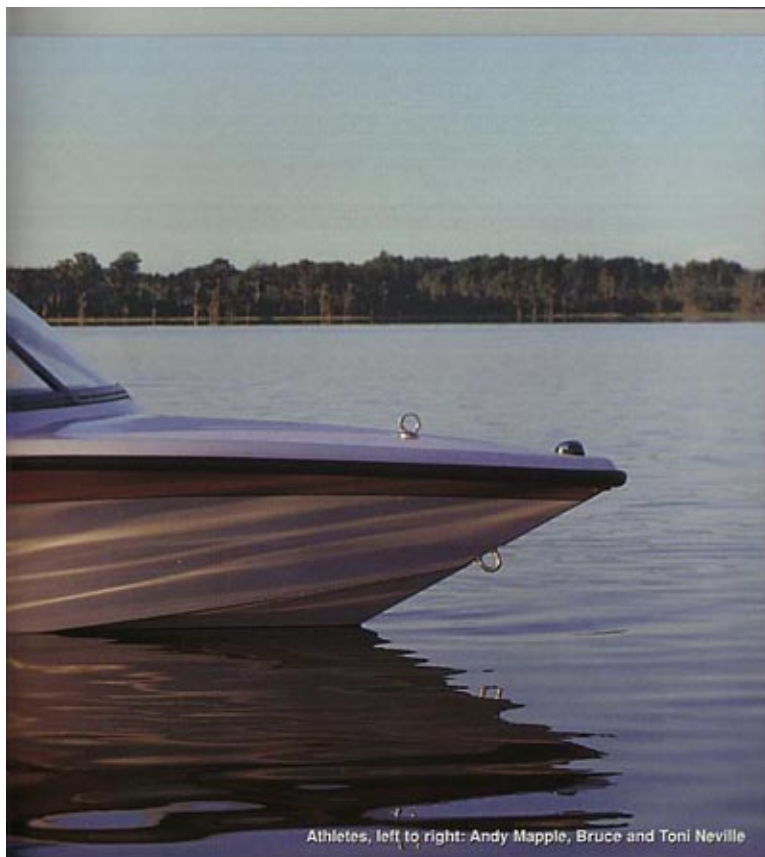

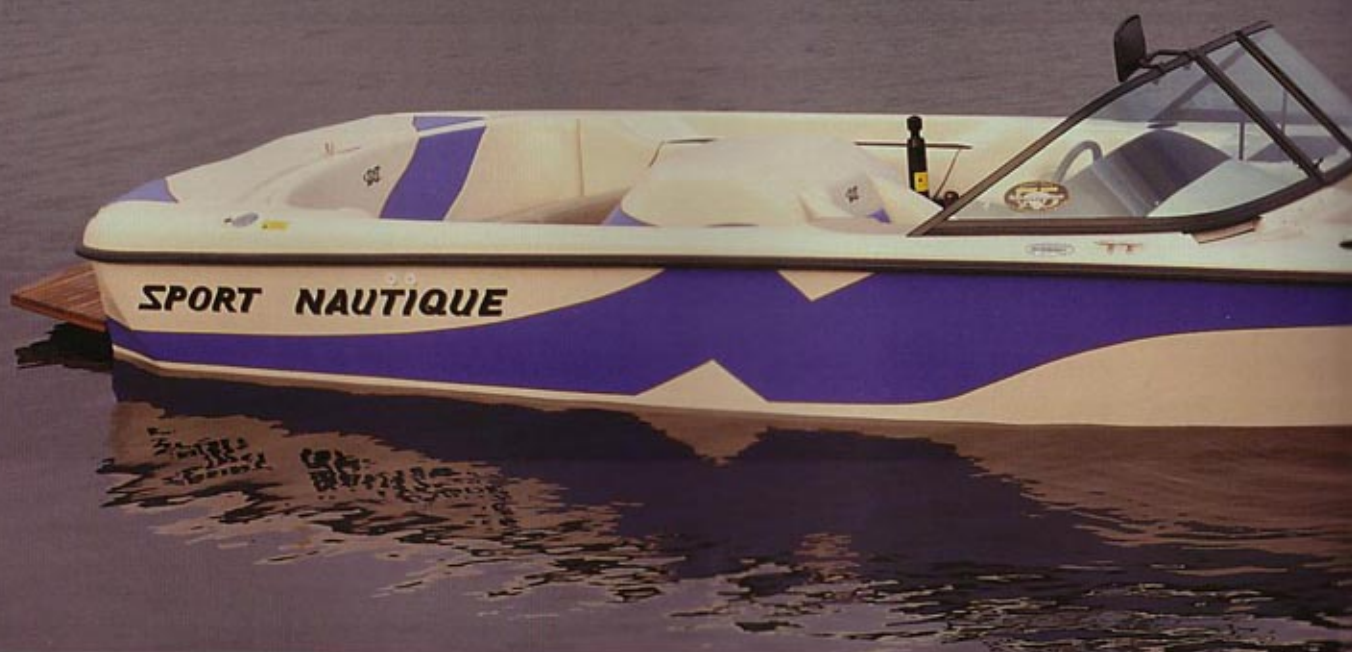

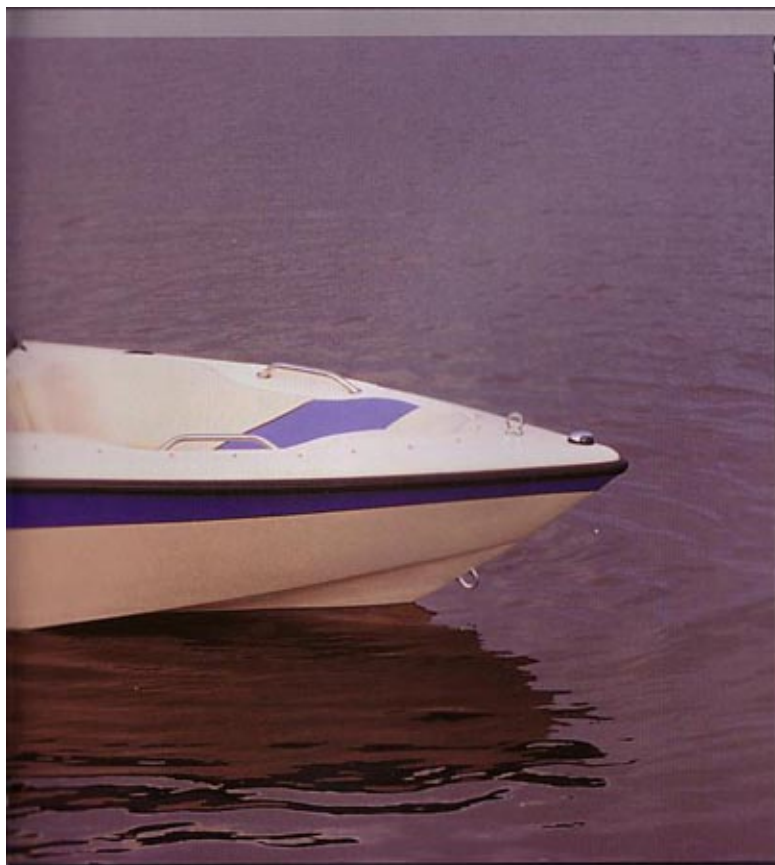

The Nautique Moment In 1925, Walter C. Meloon opened his first boat manufacturing facility, the Florida Variety Boat Company, in Pine Castle, Florida. The master of promotion, Correct Craft's founder used his original boats to pull aquaplanes, waterskiers and tow gliders, always to the crowd's delight. Once, he drove a motorized toboggan with an Austin car, only to see the automobile take a nose-dive in the water as the boat came to a stop. He received a standing ovation!

The Nautique Moment In 1945, General Dwight D. Eisenhower issued a plea for the production of 569 storm boats for a critical wartime mission. Correct Craft, one of three U.S. boat manufacturers called upon to respond, miraculously delivered 400 total boats in just 15 days. The boats helped save the day as they allowed for the early crossing of the Rhine in time to stop the Nazis from blowing up a railroad bridge at Remagen. For their contribution to the Allied victory, Correct Craft was honored with the prestigious "Army and Navy E Award."



When the **AIR NAUTIQUE** made its worldwide debut a few short years ago, it was heralded as a revolutionary new platform for wakeboarding. The first boat of its type to be dedicated to the emerging new sport had no rivals as it took the industry by storm. 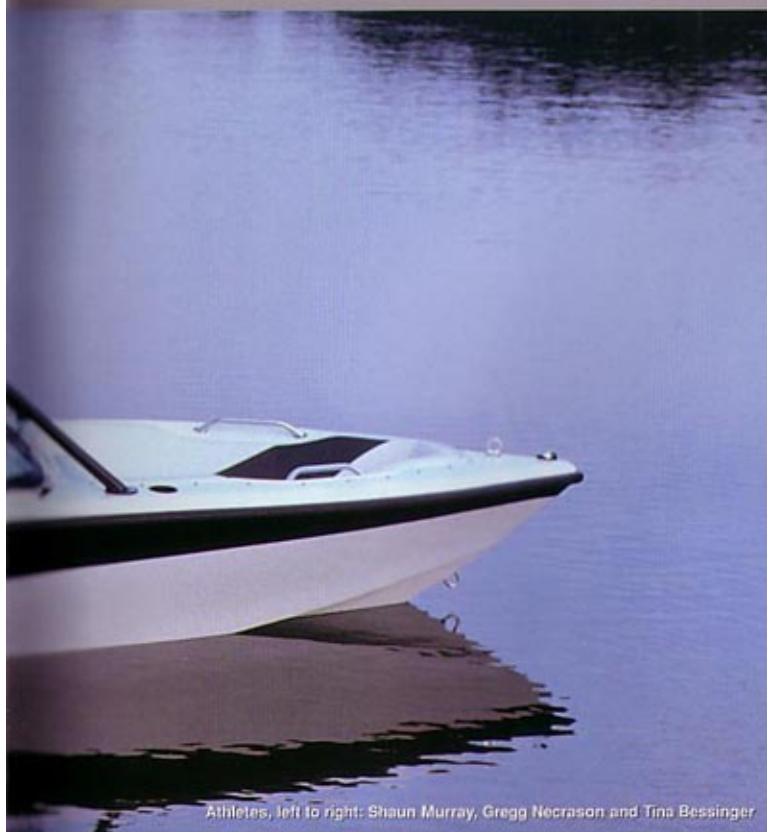

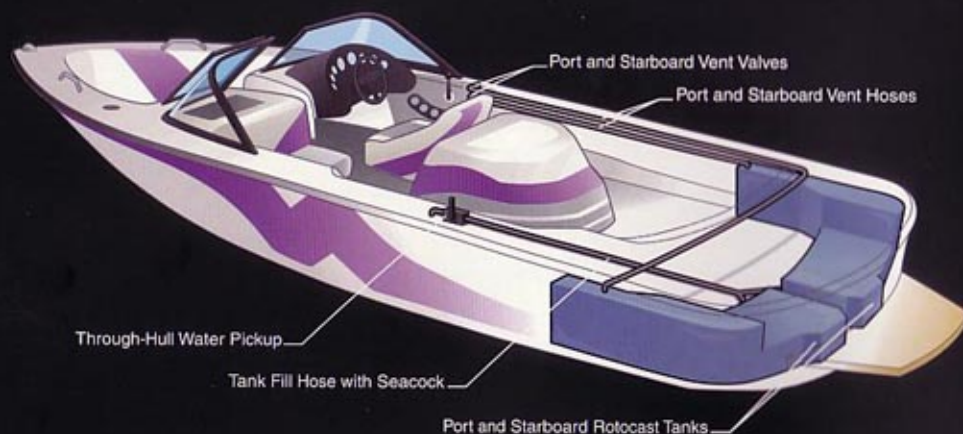
