No winch to crank or positioning of boat on trailer while on the ramp. This functional feature along with our center balance design will insure many years of fun boating and easy trailering.

What does it all mean? . . .

Over 50 years of tradition, craftsmanship, and design that few can match or even talk about. It also means the best boating investment you can buy. Here's why... because few manufacturers go through the painstaking layup process and quality control steps that we use. Every phase of layup and production is checked off by a Quality Control Inspector. Recards are kept on every boat, and you can bet if his name is attached it had better be right before it goes out. In addition, all models are 8.1. A. certified with rigid, annual inspections made by both independent marine laboratories and U.5. Coast Guard.

The straight inboard is our only power package. There are many power units on the market today, and most of them are classic cases of designed malfunction. We stayed with the straight inboard for some very basic reasons. We use a standard inboard engine much like the one you may have,



but here's where we part company. Yours must take rotating energy from the end of the engine's drive shaft, turn that engine at right angles, lead it down below the surface of the water, turn it at right angles again and then spin a prop with it. A stern drive must also have forward, neutral and reverse gears in it and it must also pick up water, pump it to the engine, bring it back and eject it, as well as ejecting the engine's exhaust fumes. Now that's a lot of work to do. You can only do it with a very sophisticated series of cogs, splines, gears and bearings. And you're wondering why yours is in the repair shop most of the time?

Now let's go back to where we parted. Every Correct Craft uses inline power. The engine produces rotary energy which turns a drive shaft, which turns a prop in water. It's all in-line, simple and only a gear box is needed between the drive shaft and prop. Want to go boating instead of going to your service agent? The choice is yours and it should be simple.

After 50 years, we get pretty particular about the quality of component parts that go into all boats. The fact remains that we have found few that could give us Correct Craft quality. So we decided to make them ourselves. Every strut, rudder, log and shaft are machined by Correct Craft. We bend our




own metals and we make our own trailers. We are particular because we know you are, and you are our main concern.

It is hard, if not impossible, to condense over 50 years of boar building experience into a few paragraphs of print. We've made a few mistakes during our tenure but our accomplishments can be seen in the finest boating investment on the market today. Few manufacturers can use the term "investment" regarding their boats, but the fact remains that over the past five years our Ski Nautique has not depreclated in value and in most cases has returned the same dollars as the initial investment.

Although every boat has specific features that are unique to its design, we can not list them all here, our standard features that you should be aware of are listed on inside back cover. Oh yes, by the way, ask your dealer how many of these features are standard with other manufacturers.
