








A Tradition of Quality Continued

standards.




















COMPLETING THE PACKAGE -CORRECT CRAFT TRAILERS

Securely cradling the Ski Nautique 2001 from lake to lake is a very important job. This aspect of boating is often overlooked, but Correct Craft has devoted time and attention to developing a truly superior trailer. Custom-fitted to the Ski Nautique 2001, these trailers are literally the state of the art in secure boat transportation.

Correct Craft trailers are BIA certified. The frame is constructed of 4" channel for exceptional strength. The 2" solid steel axle is durable and resistant to moisture and rust. Heavy duty springs have raised the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating to an impressive 4660 pounds. Support bunks are precisely matched to the hull for even weight distribution and a secure ride. Fenders are strong, flat and function as a convenient step plate.

Correct Craft trailers are designed for maximum operational convenience. The drive-on, drive-off feature allows complete launch and recovery without having to leave the boat. The trailer completes a very high quality boating package. As such, the Ski Nautique 2001 will deliver years of boating pleasure, exciting skiing and easy trailering.
