

A LITTLE ABOUT OUR HISTORY

W. C. Meloon began building boats in Pine Castle, Florida, in 1925. After several company name changes, Meloon settled on "Correct Craft" and the company grew to be the world's second largest boat manufacturer—building everything from dinghies to 50-foot cabin cruisers.

Today, Correct Craft has honed its line to a half dozen towboats and runabouts 22 feet and under. Our flagship model, the Ski Nautique, originated in 1961 and has been in existence longer than most boat companies. The Ski Nautique has been systematically redesigned and improved as new technology develops, keeping it and Correct Craft on the forefront

That is why Correct Craft's research and development department is constantly originating and evaluating new designs and materials for future use in Nautiques... modified versions of which are borrowed by other manufacturers.

Take for instance, Spray Relief Pockets. Correct Craft introduced these linear hull indentations in 1990 as a method of channeling boat spray down and away from the skier in tow. Similar, although less effective, versions of this technique were quickly adopted by other manufacturers and installed later that model year.

Correct Craft actually

introduced the first competition designed water ski towboat, the first ski pylon, and the first tracking fin for water skiing.

Sure, we can lay claim to an enormous number of industry firsts, but it is more important to Correct Craft not that we are first, but that we are best.

Fortunately, we are both.

Every Correct Craft boat is lake tested under actual running conditions to ensure the highest quality performance.

The good news is that we have yet to add bell bottoms to our Fashion Nautique line-but the year is still young.

There are two additional levels of upgrades including the ultimate-Bose Reference system. With a 10" marine subwoofer, compact disc changer, power amplifier and more, this Clarion system boasts 480 watts of power. Won't the neighbors love that!

Electronic Fuel Injection. Pro Tec EFI is an attractive option over other EFI systems offered today. It is the only Ford engine based EFI system created for marine use. It is a four v injector system which will be retrofittable on Correct Craft Pro Boss engines.



CORRECT CRAFT HAS AN EYE FOR **DETAILS**

Lifting rings that lift. It's really not too much to ask for lifting rings to be capable of lifting the weight of the boat. That's why Correct Craft fiberglasses its lifting ring hardware to the hull of each Nautique. That way, the weight of the boat is not suspended by the deck, but rather from the hull.

Light bright. This tiny piece of equipment has an enormous responsibility for

making your vessel seen. That's why Correct Craft uses halogen lights. They burn brighter and last longer because they are made of a non-corrosive composite material.

Hardware. Considering the wear and tear on cleats, bow eves and the like, it's no wonder they call it "hard"ware. Correct Craft uses stainless steel hardware. Through the decades, we've discovered that stainless steel lasts longer



than plated hardware in the marine environment, (Notice also that the cleats are recessed to discourage snags.)

Removable boarding platform. Believe it or not, the engineers at Correct Craft are regular people... well, as regular as engineers get anyway. And they realize that boat storage space is an issue. That's why they designed the Nautiques with a removable boarding platform. Depending on



the size of your garage, the removable platform can mean the difference between storing your boat in the garage and... adding on so you can store your boat in the garage.

Tilting Trailer Tongue. Say THAT ten times fast. While our engineers were in the space saving mode, they turned their attention to the trailer. They discovered that Ski Nautique and Sport Nautique trailers could be designed to hinge to save additional space. So, now they hinge.

Integrated Composite Stringer System (ICS)™. This stringer system is designed to keep Nautiques from flexing as they cross wakes or encounter chop. It is constructed from composite material that maintains the Nautique's reputation for providing a smooth ride. And it is literally fiberglassed to the hull instead of being glued to the hull.

Correct Craft engineers determined that fiberglass on fiberglass provides a more permanent bond than glue. That is why Correct Craft hulls are made of layers of biaxial fiberglass and not bottles of Elmer's.

It's always something. Four years ago it was the revolutionary new hull design which all but eliminates spray and wakes. The following year it was the introduction of the Pro Tec engine management system which provides increased horsepower to the prop while actually reducing fuel consumption. Last year it was a synthetic stringer system. Those are tough acts to follow. But we always manage to come up with yet another feature to capture the hearts and minds of water sports enthusiasts.

For 1994, the emphasis is on the little details that can make a big difference.

Most obvious is the more

curvaceous deck design. We picked up a few of the attributes we introduced in the Sport Nautique for 1993. We even re-introduced the rounded windshield we popularized more than 40 years ago.

The dash has taken on a new look— including a standard AM/FM/cassette stereo with waterproof speakers and gauges covered by a three year warranty.

Also new to the dash area is an emergency engine shut off switch with attaching lanyard. This attaches to the driver and is designed to shut off the engine should the driver leave the seat.

For convenience, we offer a walk-through wind-









shield option to facilitate anchoring and the loading and unloading of passengers and gear.

And while there's still a large in-floor cooler/storage area, there is an additional easily accessed cooler/ storage area in the dash.

Speaking of accessibility, don't forget to check out the hinging gull wing observer's seat. The Ski Nautique offers a wealth of storage and this hinging seat makes stowing and retrieving gear simple.


The transom ski spool and grab rails are standard features on all 1994 Nautiques as is the awesome AM/FM/cassette stereo with waterproof speakers.

Another standard feature of the Ski Nautique Open Bow is the deluxe stern seat. Not only do the seat cushions hinge forward for storage, but the center cushion snaps out to provide easy access to the transom without stomping on your nice dry vinyl.

Additional storage is located under the hinging gull wing observer's seat. Larger items, including kneeboards, skiboards and water skis store conveniently out of sight. More importantly, when you need to retrieve these items, you don't have to be a contortionist.



This year's Sport comes complete with an AM/FM/ cassette stereo and waterproof speakers. Program in your favorite stations and take to the lake.

Secure your skis in the in-floor ski locker, your kneeboards and skiboards in the convenient under bow storage area and smaller items in the readily accessible stern seat storage compartments.

Depending on the passenger arrangement, water sports enthusiasts can enjoy a tow from the transom ski spool or the teflon coated ski pylon.

Because of its modified Ski Nautique hull design, the Sport features competition caliber wakes at skiing speeds. At slower speeds, kneeboarders and skiboarders can soar for "radical air" and other mind boggling maneuvers. These sessions can be easily recorded by your video camera thanks to the standard 12 volt receptacle at the dash— so the fun doesn't have to stop at the dock!


Introducing: The Ski Nautique Paragon.

The Paragon is a limited edition Ski Nautique available to connoisseurs of classic designs. It features tree farm grown Honduras Mahogany decks and hand rubbed teak floors atop the World Championship caliber hull of the Ski Nautique—which makes this boat not only beautiful, but supremely functional as well.

Beneath the motor box you'll find the more than 300 horsepower PCM Pro Boss engine. The Pro Boss features a 1.23:1 Power Plus transmission and the incredible Pro Tec engine management system. Pro Tec is the "brain" of the system, constantly monitoring engine function for optimum performance.

The Paragon comes standard with a host of complements, including an awe inspiring Bose Reference Stereo system, featuring a 10 inch marine subwoofer, compact disc changer, power amplifier and 480 watts of power. Control of this is a mere fingertip away via infrared remote control.

All inboards are not alike. Take for example Correct Craft's Nautique Excel Closed Bow. First introduced in our 1991 line, this inboard takes advantage of a v-drive configuration which allows stern engine placement, freeing up more cockpit space. However, you still have the reliability and ease of maintenance of an inboard engine.

The Nautique Excel is excellent for large bodies of water because of its increased freeboard—you get a nice, dry ride. And thanks to its deepventry, the hull slices through even the roughest chop without effort or jarring. Best of all, the padded keel tames the water into a smooth, skiable (or barefootable) surface.

For 1994, the Nautique Excel features new gauges, an emergency shut off switch, a standard AM/FM/ cassette stereo and water-proof speakers. Add that to an already lengthy list of standard features and you have a design that will be hard to duplicate... but they'll probably try anyway.

Correct Craft has nearly seven decades of boat building experience. We pay special attention to details that will make every boating experience enjoyable.



Its inboard engine is nestled beneath a convenient padded sun lounge, leaving the cockpit open and spacious.

Because the Nautique Excel Open Bow boasts a nine passenger capacity, Correct Craft made sure there is plenty of storage.

For 1994, the Nautique Excel Open Bow features an AM/FM/cassette stereo with waterproof speakers, an emergency shut off switch and a three year warranty on gauges.

Now the whole family can come along to water ski, kneeboard, skiboard and barefoot in Correct Craft's Nautique Excel Open Bow.

HALF THE FUN IS GETTING THERE

Correct Craft trailers are custom built to provide maximum support for your Nautique. Your boat is securely nestled between the carpeted wheel wells for added security and better visibility from your tow vehicle.

For 1994, Correct Craft trailers feature radial tires for easier maneuverability and better fuel economy while towing.

All Correct Craft trailers feature solid axles, sealed wheel bearings and surge brakes— complete with a special free-backing plate for uphill backing.

Additional standard features include: lights, dolly jack, fenders, loading





coupler and pinstriping (custom paint and spare tire optional).

The Ski Nautique trailer tongue can be tilted to facilitate storage—reducing the trailer length 19 inches.

> The Ski Nautique and Sport Nautique trailers feature a hinging dolly jack which eliminates the need to crank the jack the full scope up or down.

State laws vary regarding trailer tie downs. Know your state and local laws before ordering your Correct Craft trailer. Tie-downs are standard on all Correct Craft trailers, however, the customer is responsible for buying and installing straps.

Also, take particular care when stepping on wet trailer fenders. They may be slippery.


