



he Paragon is the result of two passions: water skiing perfection and classic elegance.

It began quite innocently enough with a family's quest for the perfect water ski towboat. That quest, naturally led the clan to Correct Craft's Ski Nautique.

However, the head of the household— having assembled a respectable collection of classic, wooden boats— would not entertain the thought of having a fiberglass vessel in his fleet. The Ski Nautique would have to *look* like a classic or there would be no new ski boat.



So began the Cinderella tale of the Ski Nautique Paragon.

Craftsmen began with a new Ski Nautique— complete with its record setting hull and integrated composite stringer system. Then they painstakingly fitted tree farm grown Honduras Mahogany to the deck with stainless steel screws. The countersunk hardware was hidden by bungs — small circular plugs of matching Honduras Mahogany— to give the surface a smooth, unblemished look and feel.



The deck was then sanded, sponged and sanded again, using a finer grit sandpaper. Stain was applied to accentuate the rich, tight grain. Then six coats of Spar varnish were applied— each requiring a day or more to set.

The teak floor was similarly installed, using matching teak bungs to cover the stainless steel hardware. But instead of varnish, the teak was hand rubbed with two coats of teak oil.


The hull was painted with a linear polyurethane paint like that used on aircraft. Two coats of clear coat were applied to ensure its luster.

On the transom, the family had the name "Willie B." applied in gold leaf. (In fact, the Paragon is still affectionately referred to around Correct Craft as the Willie B.) So the family got its water ski boat and the patriarch got his classic.

But there's more to this happy ending...
