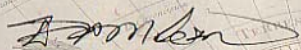

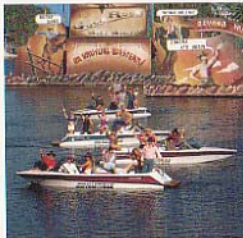

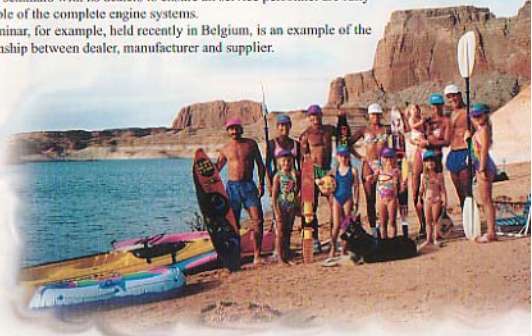

Perhaps because so much attention is focused on Correct Craft's amenities above the waterline, those important details under the water often are overlooked.

Each of the boats in the 1995 Correct Craft line contain hull details which dramatically and positively affect your skiing performance.

Known as Spray Relief Pockets, these linear hull indentations were introduced by Correct Craft in 1990 as a method of channeling positive water pressure at the transom back down into the craft's wake. Skiers refer to this as spray. Skiers hate spray.

You can actually measure the difference spray relief pockets make simply by skiing behind a Correct Craft. Cross the "NO WAKE ZONE". FEEL THE DIFFERENCE!



Each FUEL TANK is constructed of rotocast.

It is translucent, permitting a quick, visual inspection of fuel levels and remains unaffected by degradation due to rust.

All INTERIOR SEATING is also constructed from the superior Rotocast material. This produces a strong and durable support for all upholstery fittings.

ROTOCAST is an impervious, twentieth century construction material which is ideal for the marine environment and is widely used in the interior of each Correct Craft to provide you with a lifetime of trouble free enjoyment of your investment.

The REAR SEATING ASSEMBLY of all models of Nautiques is constructed of ROTOCAST and is designed to be removed to provide additional space, if desired.

For 1995, the driver's lumbar area has been redesigned to provide you with even more support.



The Integrated Composite Stringer System, (ICS) is the heart of the Correct Craft design. No other feature produces such remarkable and measurable differences as the Integrated Composite Stringer System.

A result of many years of research by Correct Craft personnel, the ICS, or substructure of the boat, was developed using composite materials after tests determined that such stringers could maintain the superior smooth ride that the Nautique line was known for.

By combining a proprietary application of biaxially laid fiberglass with AME 5000 resin, Correct Craft is able to produce a hull which is 60% stronger.

The stringer systems of Correct Craft boats are literally fiberglassed into the hull instead of merely placed on top of the surface.

A more permanent bond results in a smoother ride. Smoother rides produce more consistent skiing performance.

Higher scores. Longer jumps. More personal bests.

THE CLARION STEREO SYSTEM

Long a recognized name in a wide range of communications electronics, Clarion's involvement in the marine audio industry is based on a major commitment to creating products which have a distinct character and which are designed to be as advanced as they are truly easy to use.

The marine stereo is certainly one such product.

Each Clarion AM/FM cassette stereo system is subjected to radical extremes in temperature and exposure to the elements daily.

Each marine Clarion AM/FM cassette stereo sound system features 20 watts maximum power output amps and three levels of power upgrades UP TO 450 WATTS! Other features include pulse-width regulated power supply, ground loop isolation circuitry, gold plated connectors to eliminate noise and distortion from corrosion, the 4HEX electronic crossover, full logic tape transport system, and depending on which optional system you select, full feature controls on your CD or cassette. Fully weatherproof, 6 1/2" coaxial marine speakers are available for superior power handling and reproduction of the full stereo spectrum.

Our single four inch exhaust outlet actually REDUCES restriction typically found in twin three inch systems, not by accident, but rather by careful attention to design detail.



THE REMOVABLE SWIM PLATFORM

Two easy access pins permit the quick removal of the teak swim platform from the transom. Together with the unique, tilting trailer and fresh water flush system, Correct Craft has thought of everything for storage of your boat after each day or each season of hard use.



ISO-DAMP-CN NOISE REDUCTION

Structure-borne noise occurs in boats in which there is no provision for reducing the natural tendency for the hull and structure members to flex and vibrate as the boat reacts to the water, particularly at high speeds.

Iso-damp CN-noise reduction is a standard amenity added to the hulls to strategically reduce unnecessary noise and is found on all Correct Craft boats.
