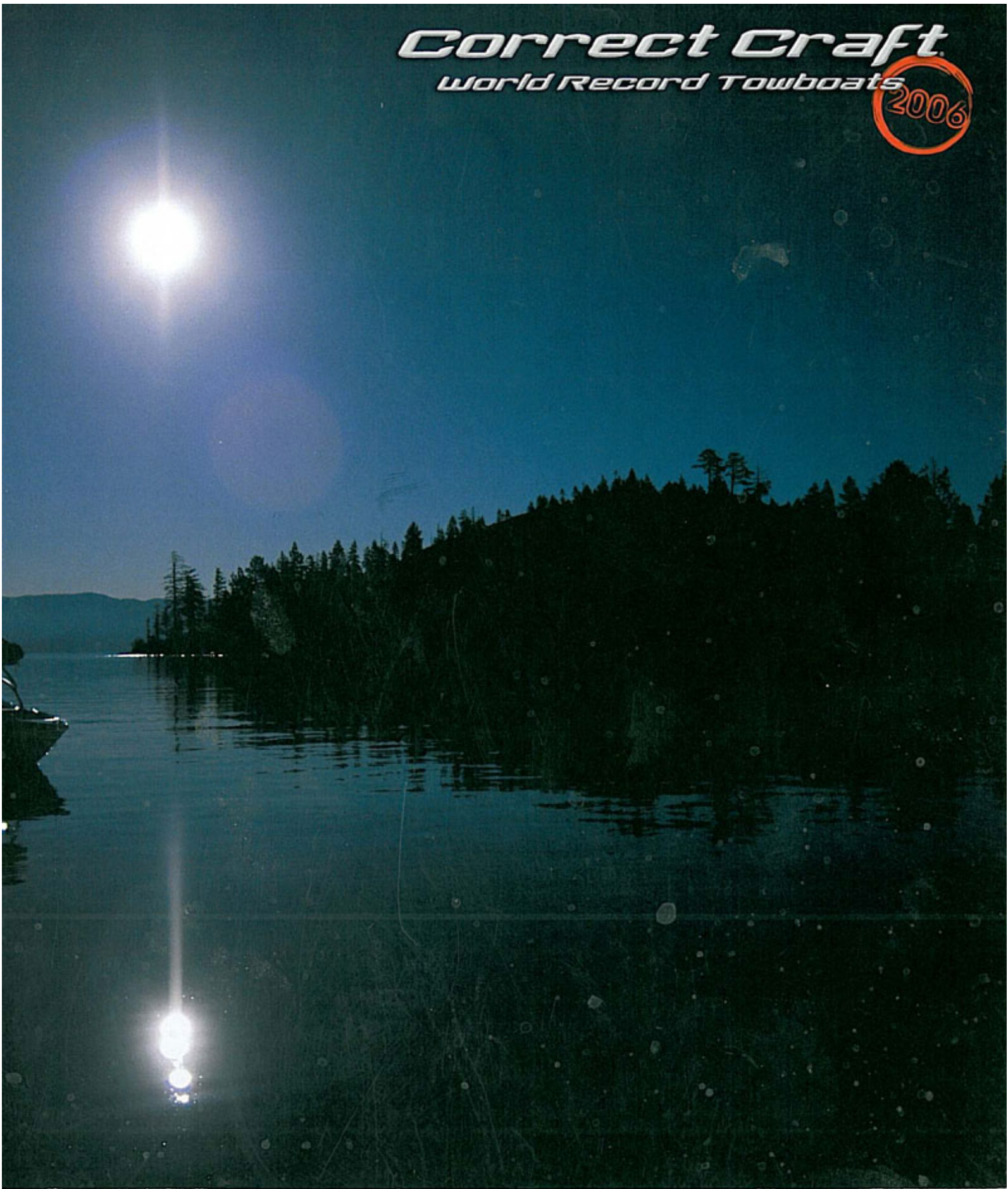

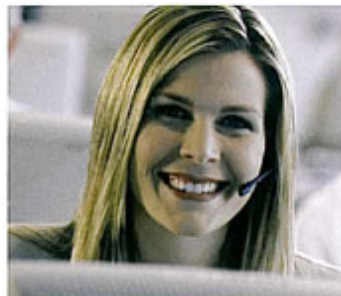

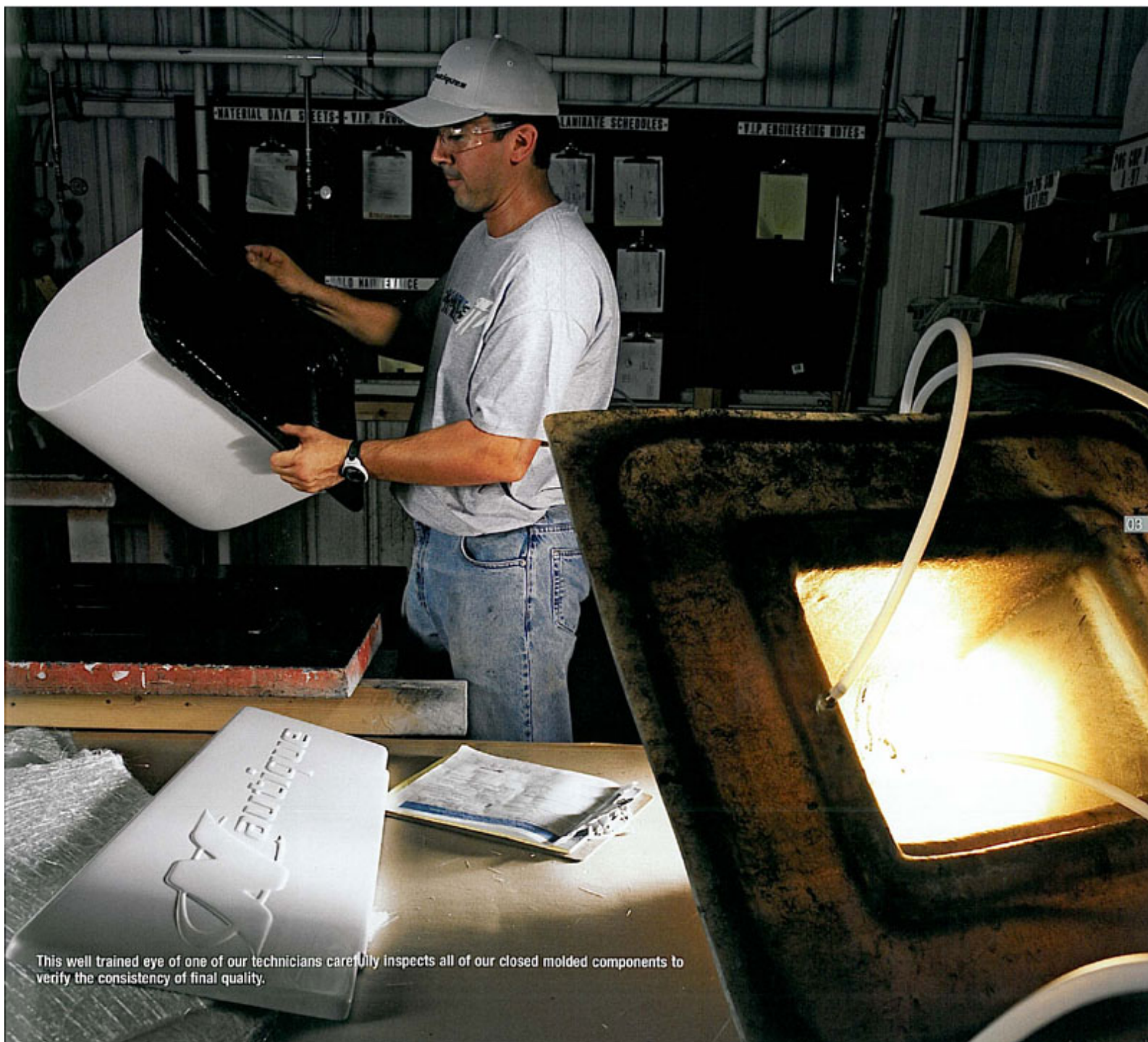

Standards

Certified Floatation Foam — Tests on the Swamped Buoyancy Test for USCG Basic Flotation conducted by NMMA laboratory in April of 2003 determined that the 2003 Model 226 Nautique would stay afloat for up to 18 hours or more following a catastrophic water intrusion (swamping).

NMMA Certification — Nautiques meet all marine industry safety standards set by the National Marine Manufacturers Association. In addition, all Nautiques meet or exceed USCG (U.S. Coast Guard) and ABYC (American Boating & Yachting Congress) requirements.

SportShift™ — Located next to the throttle on select Nautique models, *SportShift* allows the driver to engage a Hydro-Gate that changes wake size and shape right from the cockpit. It's the perfect feature for families who like to ski and wakeboard.

Adjustable Driver's Seat — The driver's seat is fully adjustable for the ultimate in comfort and visibility. It has forward and aft slide movement, swivel and lumbar support.

Raw Water Intake Seacock — Raw water comes through an intake to keep the engine cool. The seacock is an emergency valve to shut off the intake, preventing the boat from being swamped in the event of an engine malfunction.

3-Speed Heater with Defroster — A push-button control/indicator for the 3-speed heater is located on the ignition and switch panel in the Smart Pod dash. Pressing and releasing the heater button allows for adjustments from low speed to medium, high and off. An indicator light for this button illuminates if the heater is running at any of the three speeds.

Lifting Rings — Our integrated stringer system is so strong that we recommend you hang your boat by its fully functional lifting rings. Nautique is the only boat manufacturer confident enough in the quality of its boats to make this recommendation.

Interstate® Standard Marine Battery Certificate — Each Nautique comes with the Interstate Standard Marine Battery Certificate. Our Nautique dealer uses this certificate to get and keep fresh batteries at all times from Interstate Batteries. This assures every new boat is delivered with a fresh battery.

Boarding Platform — Who wants a small boarding platform? Ours are big, roomy and great looking.

Centex Muffler/Hull Hugger — Reduces exhaust noise with minimal back pressure increase on the engine, while hugging the hull to maximize interior space.

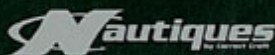
Watersports Responsibility Code
