




➤ The following document is a walkthrough on how to downgrade the firmware on an original Pebble or Pebble Steel watch that has been upgraded to a firmware newer than v2.9.1

➤ Start by downloading (to your phone) the correct version of firmware based on the hardware revision of your Pebble watch. To download the file onto your phone open this PDF on your phone and click the link or download the file on your computer and email it to yourself. To check your hardware revision go to Settings -> System -> Information -> Hardware on your Pebble watch.

- ► Pebble Firmware v2.8.1 for V2R2
- ► Pebble Firmware v2.8.1 for V3R1/V3R2/V3R3
- Pebble Firmware v2.8.1 for 102V1





Open the file on your phone after downloading and you should see a dialog similar to this.

Select "Install" to begin installing the new firmware. It is VERY important that your Pebble watch has enough battery to perform the upgrade. It is HIGHLY recommended to have the charging cable connected while doing this update.






While the firmware is loading it is VERY important that the process is not interrupted. If the update process is interrupted this can result in the watch becoming unusable.

Some iPhones have trouble loading a custom Pebble firmware. If the phone does not cooperate, try a different phone. Android phones tend to work better for this.

Once the update is finished loading on your watch it is important that you DO NOT let your phone pair to the watch until you have uninstalled the "Pebble" app and installed the "Pebble OLD VERSION" app.

Once you see one of these screens, exit the "Pebble" app and uninstall it from your phone. For iPhone instructions on uninstalling an app <u>click here</u>. For Android instructions <u>click here</u>.




- ▶ If you are using an iPhone you will need to open the Settings app, go to Bluetooth, and forget both Pebble watch devices (they should be named the same except one has an "LE" after it). Forgetting the Pebble watch is not necessary on Android phones.
- Now open either the App Store (iPhone) or Google Play Store (Android) on your phone and install the "Pebble OLD VERSION" app. The icon should look like this:




▶ Once the "Pebble OLD VERSION" app is installed on your phone, open the app and follow the instructions to setup your Pebble watch. This setup should look similar to the very first time your watch was connected to your phone. It is now safe to let your phone pair and connect to your watch to update it.





The "Pebble OLD VERSION" app should detect that the firmware is out of date and will update it to the official v2.9.1 from Pebble.





Once your Pebble watch is finished upgrading, all that's left is to reload the Nautique Surf Select app onto your watch and you're good to go!
